Participant's agreement to accept and abide by the CBVC Policy. Parents of players participating in the organization of Code Blue Volleyball are required to follow the code of conduct as set forth by CBVC:

- 1. It is my responsibility to be prepared for practice and engaged at tournaments.
- 2. I will give my best effort at all practices and games.
- 3. I will listen and learn from my coaches and teammates.
- 4. I will treat my coaches, teammates, opposing players, officials, and spectators with respect regardless of age, race, creed, color, gender or abilities and I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- 5. I understand that playing time is not guaranteed and recognize that my playing time based on my effort, my attitude and my ability to be coachable during practices and tournaments.
- 6. I will attend every practice and game that I can on time, and I will notify my coach beforehand if I cannot attend.
- 7. I understand that the equipment that is provided to me is intended to strengthen my skills. Therefore, I will not abuse the tools that I have been extended the use of.
- 8. I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike behavior with any official, coaches, player or any parent (including my own) such as arguing, booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
- 9. I will encourage my own parents to engage in good sportsmanship.
- 10. I will accept victory and defeat with the same dignity.
- 11. I will always play within the rules of the game and engage in good sportsmanship.
